Drewchin is one half of music duo Guardian Alien, but primarily she is Eartheater. Though at first note she could be branded a singer, there is much more to her than that. Her whole body is her voice, and she uses it as a powerful and influential device, forging a space for her work to be heard. As Eartheater, Drewchin has released two albums, Metalepsis and RIP Chrysalis, both critically acclaimed. Her sound is a mix of electric quitar and synthesizer samples that swirl together into something that could be characterized as psychedelic, with a touch of ancient folklore.

It is something very peculiar, eclectic and complex. Something cyber-alien-ish yet totally naturalized. In Drewchin's words, "Eartheater is the type of project where "the experience", past or present, is never obsolete and can always be referenced in the poetic mirage-it's a conversation in search of elegance."






Graphic Image featuring Kanye West's 3rd collection for The WILD Online (3D collage)






**Left:** Photography and layout for RHODWAONG Mood images (brand development) with warped text.






