## Design Visual Statement



#### History of violence against women:


Throughout history, violence against women has been accepted and even condoned. More than 2,000 years ago, Roman law gave a man the power to kill his wife. In the 18th century, English common law allowed a man to discipline his wife and children with a stick or whip no wider than the width of his thumb. This "rule of thumb" prevailed in Britain and the United States until the end of the 19th century. Many feminists claim that violence against women is the result of an entrenched patriarchal culture that encourages and rewards male dominance. In patriarchal cultures, men are more likely to use violence to maintain their dominance, they say. Despite society's claims to abhor violence, we often view aggressive people as heroes. In male cultures, heroes are often based on some kind of violence.




#### Muse Interview

My body is scar-prone and bruises easily, for example a slight bump can cause my body to bruise.




My understanding of fragility is: weakness also means that it cannot be discovered by others. It can be a tool to show weakness, but sometimes it can also be a joke.
